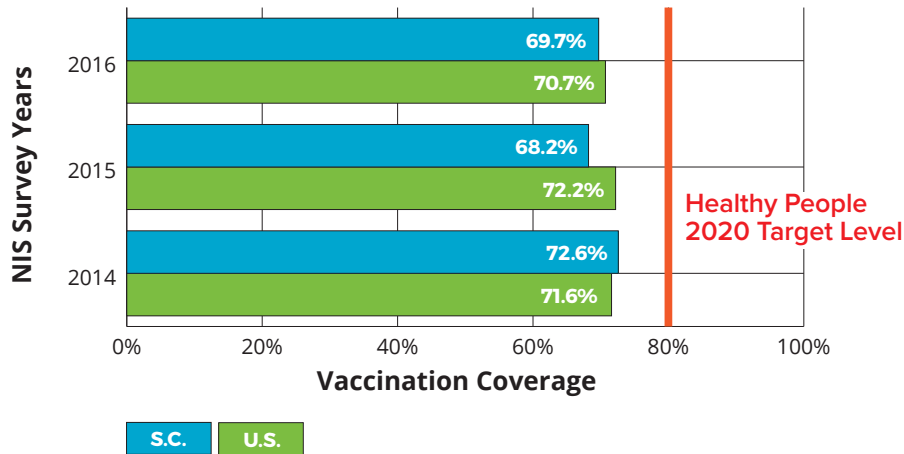


## Childhood Coverage Rates

Estimated Vaccination Coverage with Combined 7-vaccine series<sup>§</sup> Among Children Aged 19–35 Months, 2014–2016<sup>1</sup>



<sup>§</sup> The combined 7-vaccine series includes ≥4 doses of DTaP, ≥3 doses of Polio, ≥1 dose of measles-containing vaccine, Hib full series, ≥3 HepB, ≥1 Var, and ≥4 PCV.

Coverage rates for children 19–35 months of age are slightly below national rates.<sup>1</sup> However, over **94.5 percent of kindergarten children** were up to date with their vaccinations for the 2017–18 school year.<sup>2</sup>

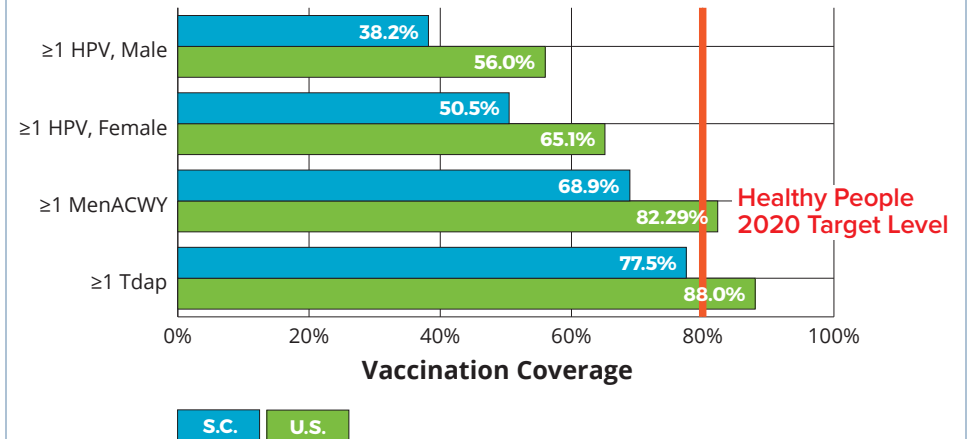

## Adolescent Coverage Rates<sup>4</sup>

South Carolina has **lower coverage** estimates than national rates for all ACIP recommended **adolescent vaccines**.

## Influenza Vaccination Rates<sup>5</sup>

During the 2016–17 flu season:

- **47.4 percent** of eligible South Carolinians age 6 months and older were vaccinated for flu.
- **55.5 percent of children** age 6 months–17 years were vaccinated for flu.
- **69.9 percent of adults** age 65 years and older were vaccinated for flu.

### Abbreviations:

DTaP = diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, and acellular pertussis vaccine (includes children who might have been vaccinated with diphtheria and tetanus toxoids vaccine, or diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, and pertussis vaccine); Polio = poliovirus vaccine; MMR = measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine; Hib = Haemophilus influenzae type b vaccine; HepB = hepatitis B vaccine; Var = varicella vaccine; PCV = pneumococcal conjugate vaccine; Tdap = tetanus toxoid, reduced diphtheria toxoid, and acellular pertussis; MenACWY = meningococcal conjugate; HPV = human papilloma virus; ACIP = Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices
